

SUMMER UNIFORM

The Summer Uniform of The Great Kanawha River Navy consists of a GKRN regulation short sleeve white shirt with epaulettes on the shoulders, a GKRN regulation white fabric belt with brass buckle, white duck trousers (NOT tailored like painters pants or jeans) are the norm; however, some Admirals prefer a better grade of white trousers to obtain a better fit, and black shoes or loafers with white socks. The cloth type GKRN emblem (provided) is to be hand stitched to the left side breast pocket. (Machine sewing eliminates the use of the pocket.)

In 2017 it became known that regulation short sleeve white shirt supplier had gone out of business. Admiral Frank Coulter, the Quartermaster in 2017 surveyed the market and found a replacement. The Board of Trustees voted to change the White Shirt Design for the Summer Uniform. The new shirts cost approximately \$43 and can be obtained by going to the website noted below. Go to search bar in their website and type in the Item number below. You will find a Flying Cross Men's 65 35 Poly Cotton Duro Poplin Short-Sleeve Shirt.

You will select a neck size for shirt before ordering.
